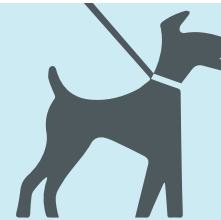

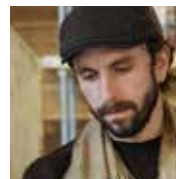
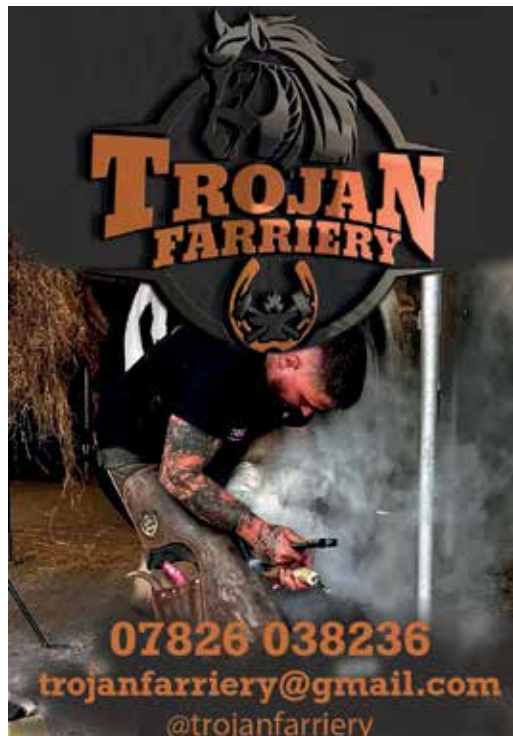


## Nathan Outlaw

# Welcome to the Beer and Cider pages



Once again, the Abbfest volunteers are here to welcome you to South Devon's friendliest festival.

And, once again, the County's brewers and cider makers are treating us to some wonderful drinks, over 120 beers and more than 40 ciders.

These are so different from the tasteless offerings from the chemical factories of the two global companies that own the vast majority of Britain's drinks labels.

We now have three choices of low / zero alcohol beers on keg, with cans of Exeter Brewery's luscious Darkness Low available at the wine bar.

As usual, we have labelled the beers and ciders with their strengths and shades. For drinkers preferring lager there are many beers to choose from, look for **yellow** hewed labels and highlights in the programme. Dark beers such as stouts and porters are on a tawny background and amber ales on **green**.

Please note that some brewers don't use finings and are vegan friendly, so their beer may be cloudy. Don't reject it, that's how it is designed to be. These beers are marked by . Similarly, some

beers are gluten free and marked GF. (Information has been supplied by the producers).

All the brewers, and many pubs have supported Abbfest, along with so many local businesses. We would not be able to bring your glorious festival to you without their generous support.

As always, we ask people to drink sensibly and not over imbibe. After all, we are open for three days, so why not spread the time and enjoy yourself for longer?

Please remember that all our hard-working staff are volunteers who give generously of their time and energy. While many have been helping for a few years, others are new and inexperienced, so please be patient at busy times. A thank-you to them is always welcome!

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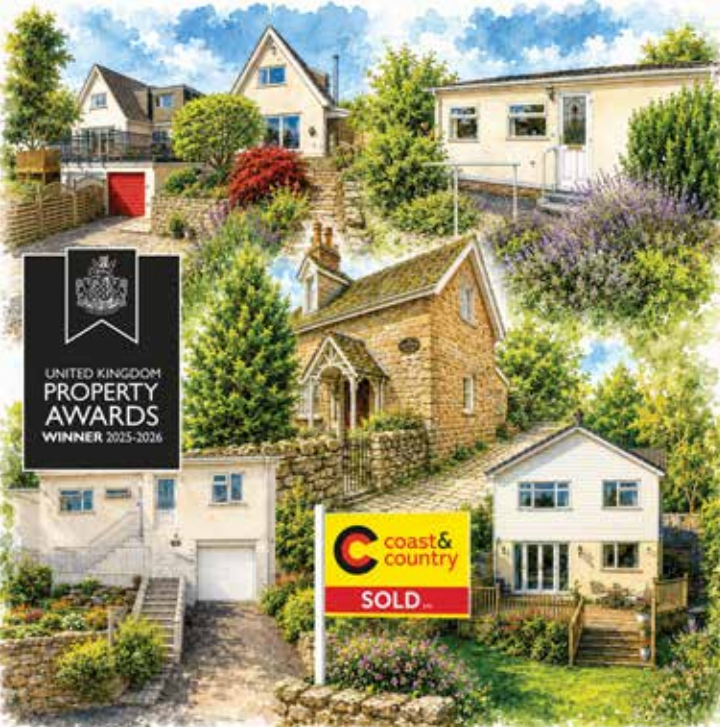

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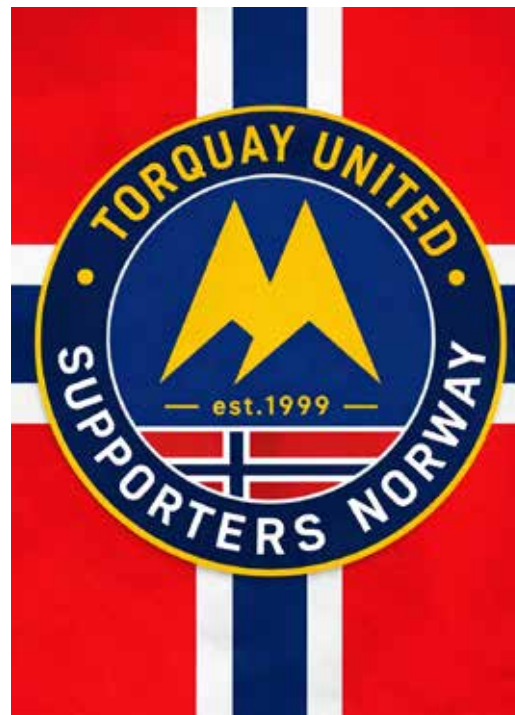
